Sparkling Pointe Seduction Blanc De Noirs 2014

North Fork of Long Island

An expressive nose combines dark cherry pate de fruit with a touch of bartlett pear. A creamy mousse imparts a sense of finesse and texture, layered with flavors of raspberry, shortbread, and pastry cream. Crisp acidity is highlighted by the rich mid-palate and long finish.

Riesling 2018

Catskills

A complex and rich Riesling with vibrant fruit aromas on the nose and notes of honey and cantaloupe on the palate paired with a bright acidity to balance out the sweetness.

McCall Chardonnay Reserve 2015

North Fork of Long Island

This reserve wine is started in stainless steel and finished in semi-neutral French oak for 14 months. Possessing layers of tropical fruit with a hint of cinnamon, 100% Malolactic fermentation creates a creamy, butterscotch finish.

Hermann J. Wiemer Riesling Noble Select

Magdalena Vineyard 2015

Finger Lakes

The Noble Select grapes picked from Magdalena Vineyard are spice-rich and acid driven. A citrus flower and ginger nose open for densely packed flavors of yellow apple crumble and mango puree. This wine will cellar comfortably for decades.

McCall Merlot Reserve 2012

North Fork of Long Island

This full-bodied wine possesses aromas of dark fruit, cedar, blackberries, black cherry, and chocolate.

Martha Clara Estate Reserve Malbec 2015

North Fork of Long Island

The nose is concentrated and focused showing notes of cedar and cocoa powder with suggestions of dried herbs. The palate is medium bodied, but full flavored. Notes of dried fruit and ripe plum abound with suggestions of sundried tomato.

McCall Cabernet Franc Reserve 2014

North Fork of Long Island

This wine is hand-harvested from vines planted in 1982 by the Gristina Family and taken over by the McCalls. They carefully select their finest barrels for extended aging in French oak. This wine shows beautiful tannins and rich dark fruits with hints of spice.

Raphael Estate Primo Winemaker Reserve 2013

North Fork of Long Island

A balanced full-bodied wine with complexity and flavor, softened by velvety tannins. These reserve grapes are hand-harvested & sorted, wild-fermented, and aged for 18 months in French oak barrels before bottling unfiltered and unfined. This wine was structured to age gracefully.

The Vineyard at Windham Diamond 2018

Finger Lakes

Known as “Moore’s Diamond,” this special grape was cultivated specifically for New York’s premium wine growing terroir. Diamond is a bold wine with a strong grape flavor and nose that it shares with a complex side of exotic pineapple and peach. Our Diamond has the perfect balance of crispness and carbonation that makes it challenging to keep your glass full.

Hermann J. Wiemer Cuvée Brut 2013

Finger Lakes

Specially selected Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes blend beautifully to create the base wine for this sparkling brut. Red fruit melds with ripe citrus and honeysuckle while crisp bubbles lead to a refreshingly clean finish.

Millbrook Chardonnay 2016

Hudson Valley

This wine possesses clean and bright aromas with notes of Empire apple and Asian pear. Flavors of mandarin orange, pear, honeydew melon, and cantaloupe are enhanced with a pleasant acidity that lingers on the finish.

Weis Grüner Veltliner 2019

Finger Lakes

This wine possesses beautifully soft acidity with a subtle hint of honeydew on the nose and a white pepper finish. This wine is a perfect pairing for light cheeses or grilled seafood.

Dr. Konstantinos Frank Gewürztraminer 2017

Finger Lakes

Clean and delicate on the nose with white flowers, orange zest, and lychee, with a touch of white pepper and ginger. This off-dry white wine is balanced with lively acidity and beautiful flowers of honeysuckle, orange blossom, cardamom, and lychee with a mouth-coating long finish.

Paumanok Sauvignon Blanc 2017

North Fork of Long Island

This wine is fresh and vibrant with aromas of lemon, followed by more subtle mineral and herbaceous notes. Medium-bodied with citrus flavors, crisp acidity and a pleasant, dry finish. Brisk notes of lemon, pineapple rind, and peach kick off this zesty, refreshing Sauvignon Blanc.

The Vineyard at Windham Semi-Dry Riesling 2018

Catskills

This wine possesses hints of apricots, peaches, and citrus on the nose followed by Granny Smith apple and ripe stone fruit on the palate.

Catskills

This golden Riesling has predominate notes of Meyer Lemon and citrus blossom on the palate, with pear and a hint of jasmine on the nose. This Riesling finishes with its gripping acidity leaving a savory minerality in your mouth.

Rosé

RG|NY Scielo NY Rosé 2018

North Fork of Long Island

A complex blend of ripe strawberry and lychee. This wine’s well-balanced acidity creates a fresh explosive start with a long and elegant finish.

Osmote Cabernet Franc Rosé 2019

Finger Lakes

Slightly darker than the 2018 vintage with a touch more acidic backbone, yet all of the weighty texture you’ve come to expect from Osmote.

McCall Rosé of Pinot Noir 2019

North Fork of Long Island

Recently released in the winery’s Cutchogue tasting room, this all-pinot noir rosé shows ripe strawberry and cherry fruit qualities with notes of white flowers and the faintest earthy edge—all with wonderful balancing acidity and an elegant dry finish.

Standing Stone Saperavi 2018

Finger Lakes

This is a distinctive and versatile red table wine that balances density with brightness. Primary red and dark fruit flavors are complemented by a floral character adding a touch of delicacy to this bold red blend. Comprised primarily of Cabernet Sauvignon and Saperavi, this wine is juicy with medium tannins and pairs well with red meats or barbeque foods.

Weis Vineyards Merlot 2017

Finger Lakes

This wine possesses beautiful dark fruit notes of plum and dark cherry on the nose with a delightfully full body.

Silver Thread Blackbird 2015

Finger Lakes

This medium-bodied wine blend possesses aromas of black currants, black cherry, and black plums with hints of smoke, tobacco, ash, straw, and black licorice. It has a silky texture and excellent balance. Drink now or cellar for 5 to 8 years (76% Cabernet Franc, 24% Cabernet Sauvignon).
